\$2,500 was distributed to 5 organizations in 2017 through The Fund for Sandwich grantmaking program

### **Calmer Choice, \$500**

To support Calmer Choice training at the Oakridge Elementary School in Sandwich. Calmer Choice is a universal prevention program committed to teaching young people how to effectively and safely manage stress and resolve conflict so that they live happy, healthy, and successful lives.

### **Cape Cod Military Support Foundation, \$500**

To support the purchase of food gift cards to provide to military/Coast Guard families who are in need and residents of Sandwich.

### **Cotuit Center for the Arts, \$500**

To support an 8-week program at Sandwich High School that will introduce the performing arts to up to 20 students. The mission of CapeCodCAN is to provide opportunities for inclusion and active engagement in the visual, literary and performance arts for individuals living with developmental/intellectual disabilities on Cape Cod in collaboration with partnering agencies and organizations committed to serving people with disabilities.

### **Friends of the Sandwich Town Archives, \$500**

To support student volunteers to do data entry and digitization of collections. Collections include: Historic Photographs and Maps; Obituaries; Historical Asset files (featuring Historic Properties).

### **Sandwich Council on Aging, \$500**

To support a Temporary Homemaking and Respite program which provides homemaking, home health assistance or respite service to senior citizens who no longer receive Medicare paid services and do not qualify for the Elder Services of Cape Cod program. This is a program designed to be temporary and bridge a period of time where a client may still be frail but can improve. The goal is to prevent re-hospitalization.
