



2013 Elder and Individuals with Disabilities RFP

The following proposals are being recommended for funding, for a total amount of \$70,000:

Community Health Center of Cape Cod, \$15,000

To support the TEAMcare for Seniors with Diabetes & Depression Program to senior patients with diabetes and a diagnosis of depression. Specialized case management services specifically for this population will be provided using the TEAMcare model. The program is designed to improve disease control in patients with diabetes as well as to improve depressive symptoms, functioning, and quality of life.

DayBreak, \$20,000

To provide seed funding for "DayBreak", which is a supportive day program for memory challenged seniors on the Outer Cape. The program will be offered two days a week and will be held at the Christian Union Church in Truro. Currently, seniors from Wellfleet, Truro, and Provincetown need to travel forty-five to sixty minutes to get to one of the existing supportive day programs.

Duffy Health Center, \$20,000

To support a Chronic Disease Outreach and Care Management Project with 2 goals: 1.) to increase access to chronic care management to persons with mental illness; and 2.) to increase access to Diabetes Mellitus II (diabetes) management to Duffy patients over 60 who have complex forms of diabetes. To reach Goal 1, Duffy will build upon a partnership with Baybridge Clubhouse in Hyannis which serves those with mental health conditions and are at a higher risk for chronic disease.

Sight Loss Services, Inc., \$15,000

Through a partnership with the Audible Local Ledger, they will increase their ability to educate clients through their large print, audio and electronic newsletter, which is full of information on the latest treatments, research, and resources for the visually impaired, and increase access to local news and services through in-home placement of radio receivers.
