



2017 STRATEGIC FOCUS GRANTEES

\$46,450 was distributed to 5 organizations in the form of Strategic Focus Grants in 2017 through the Community Impact grantmaking program.

Center for Coastal Studies, \$9,950

To create a new, year-round educational program. Elements include a new museum-quality permanent exhibit, including Cape Cod's first complete large whale skeleton; and creation of outreach materials, a docent program and visitor program including a focus on local Cape public schools.

Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod, \$11,000

To support start-up costs of a second ReStore in Falmouth. Opening a new store in the Upper Cape will help draw attention to the mission of creating more affordable homes, create job and volunteer opportunities and keep household items and building supplies out of the landfill.

The Family Pantry of Cape Cod, \$10,500

To support a part-time manager for the food pantry at Cape Cod Community College. The pantry manager will create a solid infrastructure for the College Pantry to grow and to serve the full hunger need at the College.

WE CAN, \$5,000

To support a new program staff member to support expanded programming to the Lower Cape. The additional staff member would strengthen outreach and partnerships to expand WE CAN services to Eastham, Wellfleet, Truro and Provincetown.

YMCA Cape Cod, \$10,000

To support expansion of the Teen Achievers Program to Dennis-Yarmouth Regional High School. Teen Achievers is in its third year at Barnstable High School and the primary goal of the program is to see potentially at-risk teens graduate from high school and be accepted into an institution of higher learning. Last year, 56 students were served by the program in Barnstable. Funding will allow expansion into the Dennis-Yarmouth High School and will serve approximately 50 additional students for a total of 100-110.
